ORDINANCE NO. 2018-4

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANOR, ARMSTRONG COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO
PARKING WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, the Township of Manor is a Township and Municipality in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania organized and governed according to the Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township Code authorizes Board of Supervisors to regulate among other things, parking, Section 2328 and 53 P.S. § 67328; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has been granted broad powers under the Township Code at Section 1506 thereof and 53 P.S. 66506 to act for the benefit of the public welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has further noted that regulations of parking and street usage and usage of public ways are matters that require frequent revision to address changes in parking patterns, street usage, development and other natural recurring circumstances for which passage of an Ordinance is unduly cumbersome, and, therefore, it has been determined that the terms hereof shall be subject to amendment by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is necessary to further protect the public's health, safety and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of its authority under the Township Code, and the law of the Commonwealth including the authority recited herein, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED and it hereby ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Township of Manor as follows:

Section 1 **Parking Prohibited at All Times**

- (1) Eastern side of Byron Street from a point beginning 128 feet south of the intersection with Apple Way and continuing 49 feet in a southwesterly direction toward McKean Street.
- (2) Northern and Southern sides of Graff Avenue from the intersection with Sunset Street and continuing 179 feet in a southeasterly direction.
- (3) Eastern side of Hobson Drive from the intersection with Neale Avenue and continuing 49 feet in a southeasterly direction toward State Route 66.
- (4) Northern and Southern sides of Chaplin Avenue from the intersection with Meadow Street and continuing in a southeasterly direction to the entrance to the Lenape Vo-Tech parking lot.
- (5) Western side of Scenic Drive from the intersection with the entrance to the Sheetz parking lot and continuing 265 feet in a northerly direction.

- (6) Eastern Side of Sunset Street from the intersection with Bailey Avenue and continuing in a northeasterly direction to the intersection with Graff Avenue.
- (7) Northern side of School Street from the intersection with Byron Street and continuing 49 feet in a southeasterly direction toward Hill Street.
- (8) Eastern and Western sides of Buffington Drive from the gate on Armstrong School District property and continuing 1,300 feet in a northerly direction toward US Route 422.

Section 2 Handicapped Parking

- (1) Handicapped parking areas shall be those parking areas designated by the Board of Supervisors by Resolution. Applications for handicapped parking areas shall be made to the Township Secretary and shall be reviewed by the Manor Township Police Department and approved by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors.
- (2) Applications must specify that a handicapped application must be reviewed on an annual basis and will be granted for only periods of one year at a time.
- (3) A copy of each application will be kept on file in the office of the Manor Township Police Department.
- (4) Any and all handicapped signs will follow state and federal regulations and must show the penalties for any violation.

Section 3 Penalties

Any person or entity that violates a provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be subject to the appropriate penalties set forth in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (75 PA.C.S.A. § 101 et seq.) for each provision so violated.

Section 5 Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance is held, for any reason, to be invalid, such decision or decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 6 Repealer

Upon enactment of this Ordinance all conflicting Ordinances will be repealed to the extent but only to the extent inconsistent with the terms, conditions and provisions of this Ordinance.
