

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-3
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANOR, COUNTY OF ARMSTRONG,
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2024-3
SETTING FORTH CERTAIN GUIDELINES AND LIMITATIONS FOR THE
COMPENSATION OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 94 of 2024, setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the Second Class, and

WHEREAS, the population of Manor Township is 4,190, and

WHEREAS, Act 94 of 2024 authorizes the Board of Supervisors of Manor Township to determine the compensation of supervisors, subject to the limitations set forth in the act.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

1. Each supervisor of Manor Township elected or appointed to office on or after the effective date of this ordinance shall receive compensation for attending advertised general or special public meetings or hearings of the Board of Supervisors, or other meetings authorized by the Board of Supervisors at the rate of \$72.00 for each meeting attended by such supervisor, not to exceed \$1,875.00 per year.
2. In the event that a supervisor is absent from an advertised meeting or hearing, said supervisor may still receive the above referenced compensation so long as their absence is excused by the Board of Supervisors for one of the following reasons:
 - a. Family or work emergency
 - b. Illness of the supervisor or an immediate family member
 - c. Family or business travel

The supervisor must provide satisfactory documentation to the board to support an excused absence in order to receive compensation.

3. Such compensation shall be paid in quarterly installments.
4. This ordinance shall supersede any prior ordinances relating to supervisor compensation and shall become effective on January 1, 2025.
