

MEETING FRIDAY 6-19-2026, 3.00 P.M.

Meeting called to order by Chairman Palmer at 3:00P.M. followed by the pledge of allegiance.

Palmer welcomed Roger Toy to the Board

Minutes of 6/3/2026 special and regular meeting and 6/12/2026 special meeting were distributed, motion to approve by Toy, seconded by Palmer, no public comment heard, carried.

Palmer said Ordinance 2026-2 Data Centers has been advertised and is ready to adopt. Toy made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2026-2 Data Centers, seconded by Palmer, no public comment heard, carried. Palmer said the County is working on an ordinance. Palmer stated Manor Township will have some protection if a center decides to locate here.

Palmer said we may not need our skill games ordinance because they have been made illegal in PA. There are legislators working to make them legal so everything is on hold for 120 days. Toy made a motion to put our ordinance on hold, seconded by Palmer, Phillips ask if on hold not rescinded, Palmer told him we will not do anything for 120 days, carried.

Palmer said we donate each year to camp cadet. Palmer made a motion to donate \$250.00 to Camp Cadet, seconded by Toy, no public comment heard, carried.

Palmer said PSATS has a new program called Chairman Retreat and will be held August 6th and 7th in State College. Toy made a motion to pay for Palmer to attend the retreat, seconded by Palmer, no public comment heard, carried.

Palmer stated for the last 2 days his phone has been blowing up about the encampment under the Graff Bridge. Palmer said it is 2 local residents, not homeless and no threat, they are on private property, the owner wants them to leave and they have been notified, and if they don't leave, they will be charged with trespassing. Supposed to be cooking meth there but there isn't any electric there.

Toy said next Friday they will be doing Lenape Vo-Tech and Guthrie Road from Fairway to Campbell Hollow Road and if any oil left, they will do Camp Road.

Unfinished Business:

Palmer said we budgeted \$26,900.00 for a new furnace outside and the actual price will be \$19,700.00 and should be installed next week.

The park fence was damaged in the April 29th storm. Everything is purchased and waiting on installation.

Correspondence:

The Low Volume Road grant is due August 28th.

Motion to pay the bills by Toy, and give the secretary the authority to pay any bills until the next meeting, seconded by Palmer, no public comment heard, carried.
