

MEETING FRIDAY 1-16-2026, 3.00 P.M.  
Municipal Bldg. 306 Byron Street McGrann

In attendance: Supervisors Palmer and Southworth and Secretary Davis by phone

Meeting called to order by Chairman Palmer at 3:00P.M. followed by the pledge of allegiance.

Minutes of 1/5/2026 organizational and regular meetings were distributed, motion to approve by Southworth, seconded by Palmer, no public comment heard, carried.

Mortimer at 241 Garretts Run Road has requested a hidden driveway sign from PennDot. If the Board agrees it is justified, they would need to send a letter to PennDot. Palmer made a motion to send a letter but the homeowner would be responsible for the cost of the sign and post, seconded by Southworth, no public comment heard, carried.

Palmer stated 2 years ago we had to purchase new encrypted radios for the police department. Palmer found 3 radios in the evidence room that could be placed in the township trucks. Palmer would like to have them installed in township trucks so we have communication. Cost to install would be approximately \$1,200.00 for all 3 and antennas would be \$150.00 per antenna. Palmer would then call 911 and have Harringer reprogram the radios. Once installed they would have fire, EMS and be able to talk to each other. Southworth made a motion to have the radios installed, seconded by Palmer, Panian ask if there is any way to say what your saving using these, Palmer said nothing for now but will elevate communication in the township, carried. Southworth suggested putting them in the 2 big trucks and the Road Foreman's truck.

Palmer said we renewed the 287G agreement in October. Palmer said there was no reason not to do this because we already do the work. A few people don't like it but most are in favor. Southworth made a motion to continue with the Law Enforcement Agreement, seconded by Palmer, no public comment heard, carried. Palmer said 2 officers have already taken the training and could potentially get funds back, Panian said we have the 422 traffic, Palmer said Armstrong County is not immune to the activities. We have seen a few illegals.

Unfinished Business:

Street Light on Rose Street has been ordered. Panian ask if it is Drive or Street, Palmer told him Street.

Motion to adjourn by Southworth, seconded by Palmer, carried.
