

MEETING Thursday 3-12-2026 3:00P.M.

In attendance: Supervisors Palmer and Hecker, Southworth absent due to illness,
Secretary Davis is on vacation.

Meeting called to order by Chairman Palmer at 3:00P.M. followed by the pledge of
allegiance.

Supervisor Palmer stated the special meeting was needed because of a grant
application deadline of March 13, 2026, established by the Commonwealth Financing
Authority. The supervisors need to adopt a new resolution to revise the Local Share
Assessment (LSA) grant application/ Resolution. In 2025, the township submitted
applications for two grants: a Multimodal Transportation Grant through the Department
of Community and Economic Development, and an LSA Statewide Local Share
Assessment Grant via the Commonwealth Financing Authority. Both applications
targeted funding for the same roads in the Lenape Heights area to increase the
likelihood of securing financial support. The roadwork is divided into several phases,
with these applications pertaining to Phase I.


The Township was recently notified of an award of \$1.8 million from the Multimodal
Transportation Grant for Phase I. Consequently, the LSA Grant application will be
modified to address planning and implementation for Phase II. If secured, LSA Grant
funding for Phase II will be allocated toward improvements on additional roads,
including Armstrong, the remainder of Park Drive, and Manor Drive.

Supervisor Hecker made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-7, seconded by
Supervisor Palmer. No Public Comment. Motion was approved unanimously.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Additionally, the supervisors budgeted for a new police vehicle with plans for financing.
However, due to high interest rates, they decided to utilize alternative funding sources,
A motion was made by Supervisor Tag Hecker, Seconded by Supervisor Palmer to use
alternative funding on hand to purchase the police vehicle rather than finance it at high
interest rates. Motion passed unanimously.
